

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING FALL 2007

REGISTRATION

If you have not already registered we highly recommend that you set an appointment with one of our two Academic Advisors who specialize in student-athlete schedules, Tony de Shay or Andy Helman. They will assist you in the selection and registration for your courses. Appointments can be set by calling 602-787-7060. Freshman or transfer student-athletes wishing to register must first complete a Student Information Form and placement testing prior to their advisement/registration session. You should contact the PVCC Assessment/Testing Center at 602-787-7052 regarding testing times and requirements.

MANDATORY FRESHMAN ORIENTATION/COLLEGE SUCCESS

Incoming freshman must register for an orientation session (see enclosed flyer for dates and times) as well as a college success course.

TUITION

Fall 2007 tuition is due June 15 for all student-athletes who are not receiving full-tuition scholarship dollars. All non-scholarship and partial scholarship student-athletes must pay or make arrangements for payment of the balance of their tuition by the above deadline. Enclosed is an informational brochure which explains the process for financial aid recipients. Please make sure that you read, understand and take appropriate action to handle your tuition responsibilities.

BOOKS

For those who are receiving books on loan as part of their scholarship package, your team will be assigned a book pick-up date between August 13-17. You will be receiving more information regarding book dates in the future.

PHYSICALS

A free physical will be offered by the TOPS program at Midwestern University on 7/21/2007. If you choose to attend this event, a special physical form will be provided to you. For those who opt to use their own medical provider, please use the physical form provided in this packet.

MANDATORY STUDENT-ATHLETE ORIENTATION

Saturday, August 18th all student-athletes will be required to attend a mandatory orientation. This orientation will provide you with the basic guidelines, resources and information regarding athletics at PVCC. More information about this orientation will be provided to you in the future. For now, be sure to clear the date.

PUMA PATH

All student-athletes are required to have and follow an academic plan known as the Puma Path. To create your first Puma Path, student-athletes must set an appointment after September 1, 2007 with either Tony de Shay or Andy Helman. Second year student-athletes will be required to see advisement only if there is a problem with their current path. You will be notified by mail, if there is such a problem.
