## Financial Aid Application for Summer

Summer Sessions at PVCC are considered the end of the academic school year. The eligibility of each student aid applicant for summer session is based on remaining annual loan and grant limits.

You cannot be considered for summer aid unless you are enrolled in an eligible degree or certificate program.

### Pell Grant

Students who have Pell Grant funds remaining – Those who attended fall and/or spring on a less-than-full-time basis (or not at all) – may use these funds for summer classes.

Students, who attended **PVCC OR ANY SCHOOL** as a full time student during both fall and spring terms, have utilized their full Pell Grant allotment, and have no funds remaining for summer. If you have exhausted your Pell Grant funds, you may be considered for alternate funding if available.

### Federal Direct Loans

All students applying for summer loans **must** be continuing PVCC students.

To be considered for student loans during the summer, you must be enrolled **at least half time** (6 credit hours or more) during Summer Session One. Any Eight (8) week session is included as part of Summer Session One; and the entire summer is defined as one period of enrollment.

- Summer I, 5 Week session (6/1 – 7/1)
- Summer I, 8 Week session (6/1 – 7/22)

### Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)

All summer awards are contingent upon successful completion of prior terms.

If you are not meeting satisfactory academic progress (SAP) standards after spring 2010 grades are posted, your financial aid award will be cancelled for the summer 2010 term. Classes will not be held for students that do not meet satisfactory academic progress (SAP). You would then need to pay the balance due on your student account to ensure that your course(s) are not dropped. ### Disbursement

- **ALL** aid disbursements are handled through the Fiscal (Cashier's) Office.
- Funds will be disbursed in two parts, according to the level of enrollment in each session.
- Balance (refund) checks will be disbursed during that session, if applicable.
- Students enrolled in summer session one (I) and summer session two (II) might want to purchase all course materials and books at the beginning of summer session one(I).
- Students enrolled in one session only will be awarded according to his/her enrollment status during that session.
