
Dear Dr. Dale:

This letter is formal notification of the action taken by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission at its meeting on June 29-30, 2010. The Board of Commissioners granted the associate nursing program continuing accreditation with the condition that your program submit a Follow-Up Report in 2 years.
