1 Program Prerequisites and Requirements Before Applying to MaricopaNursing:

Minimum grade required in all classes is a "C"

CHM130+CHM130LL or higher MAT090 & RDG 100 (prereq)	Fundamental Chemistry with lab or one year high school chemistry	0 - 4 credits
BIO201 RDG100 RDG 095 or higher (prereq) High school BIO, or BIO156 or BIO181 in the past 5 Years (prereq)	Human Anatomy and Physiology I The prereq is one-year high school biology or BIO156 or BIO 181 in the last 5 years. It is HIGHLY recommended students who plan to use high school biology as the pre-req, and those who have not had BIO156 or 181 in the past 5 years, score 70% or higher on the free Biology Assessment test to determine if they are ready for BIO201.	4 credits
ENG 101 or 107	First Year Composition	3 credits
MAT 140, 141, 142 or higher	College Mathematics or higher Mathematics	3 - 5 credits

- Statement of High School graduation or GED on the application (recommend HS transcript/GED on file in A&R).
- Transcripts from outside Maricopa Community Colleges **must be** evaluated for all courses (grade of "C" or better). Request official transcripts from all Colleges/Universities attended to be mailed to PVCC Admissions and Records Office. Check with A&R to see if transcripts arrived. For College and University transcripts you **must request an official evaluation of the transcripts** at www.pvc.maricopa.edu/admissions/transcript-evaluation. This can take up to six weeks so do not delay!
- Applicant must have an unrestricted Arizona Dept. of Public Safety **Level One** Fingerprint Clearance Card. It can take up to 10 weeks to receive a FCC. To apply visit: <http://www.azdps.gov>
- HESI A2 Entrance Exam: 80% or higher in English, 75% or higher in Math. Scores must be satisfied on a single attempt of the test. You do not have to take the Science part of the test. If passing scores are not achieved, there is a 60 day waiting period before you may retest. Study guides are available online and in the bookstore. - Acknowledgement of *Criminal Background Check Requirements* (part of the application).

After satisfying all of the above, you must submit an application to a Nursing Advisor only

- Review the 'Application Process' section of the Nursing Information Packet.
- Complete **all** of the information on the application -- including **everything** on page two.
- Bring your application, HESI A2 results and Fingerprint Clearance Card with you when you apply.
- An incomplete application will not be accepted.

2 Nursing Program Co-requisites:

These are **not** required to submit a Nursing application. We recommend they are completed while on the wait list. BIO202 is required to enter Block 2 and BIO205 is required for progression into Block 4.

Concurrent Enrollment Program (CEP) AAS & BSN

NAU

Students will take 30 credits of upper level NAU classes before, during and after their acceptance into the CEP. Classes are held in Phoenix and online. 3.0 GPA required in specific classes. NAU requires additional prerequisites: See CEP link

ASU

Students will take 38-45 credits of upper level ASU classes before, during and after their acceptance into the CEP. Classes are held online. 3.00 GPA required in specific classes. ASU does not accept HS Chemistry

Upper Iowa University

Students will take 43-45 credits of upper level UIU classes before, during and after their acceptance into the CEP. Classes are hybrid. 2.5 cumulative GPA required.

Ottawa University

Students will take 34-44 of upper level OU classes before, during and after their acceptance in to the CEP. Classes are online. 2.5 GPA required in specific classes.

Franklin Pierce University

Students will take 30 credits of upper level FP classes before, during and after their acceptance in to the CEP. Classes are online. 2.5 cumulative GPA required.

Grand Canyon University

Students will take 30-36 credits of upper level GCU classes. 2.5 GPA required

(CEP) AAS/ MSN

Grand Canyon University

Students will take 36-66 upper level classes during and after their acceptance in to the CEP. Classes are online. A cumulative 3.0 GPA and bachelor's degree are required.

MCCC Mid-Point AAS/BSN

ASU – There is an opportunity for Block 2 or Block 3 RN students to apply for ASU's BSN program to begin in Block 3/4 and the class prerequisites are the same as for the CEP.

NAU – There is an opportunity for Block 2 RN students to apply for NAU's BSN program to begin in Block 3 and the class prerequisites are the same as for the CEP.

GCU - GCU's program allows 84 transferable credits, and does not require any specific prerequisite classes.

Upper Iowa – Complete Blocks 1 and 2 and have a cumulative GPA of a 2.5 or higher from all schools attended.

Franklin Pierce – Complete Blocks 1 and 2. Complete AGEC and have a 2.5 cumulative GPA from all schools attended.
