ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ U.S. Birth Certificate and Photo ID (current high school photo ID, Arizona State ID, or Arizona Driver's License/Permit) OR
- ✓ U.S. Passport, Foreign Passport with United States Visa, Permanent Residency
- ✓ Unofficial High School Transcript with a minimum of 2.6 GPA
- ✓ Two letters of recommendation from a counselor or instructor from your school
- ✓ Short Personal Essay

Complete additional 25-30 credits needed for an Associate's degree (60-64 credits) and transfer to a University for a Bachelor's degree. Most programs at the three Arizona universities allow a maximum transfer of 64 community college credits. Some universities and/or Maricopa transfer partners allow more credits to be completed at the Community College level.
